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What Does “Inclusive University Experience” Mean?

- Feeling welcomed and respected
- Equal access to academic and social opportunities
- Clear expectations and fair treatment
- Sense of belonging within the university community



Why Inclusion Matters for Ukrainian Students

- Many students face displacement and uncertainty
- Academic challenges are often linked to emotional stress
- Inclusive practices reduce isolation and disengagement
- Supportive environments improve persistence and success



The Academic (Tutor) as a Key Inclusion Actor



- Daily contact with students
- Shapes classroom culture and norms
- Influences student confidence and participation
- Acts as a guide within the academic system



Providing Clear Academic Structure

- Transparent course requirements
- Clear assessment criteria
- Predictable timelines and deadlines
- Accessible course materials





Communicating Expectations Clearly

- Explain academic rules and procedures
- Avoid assumptions about prior knowledge
- Provide written and verbal clarification
- Encourage questions and dialogue

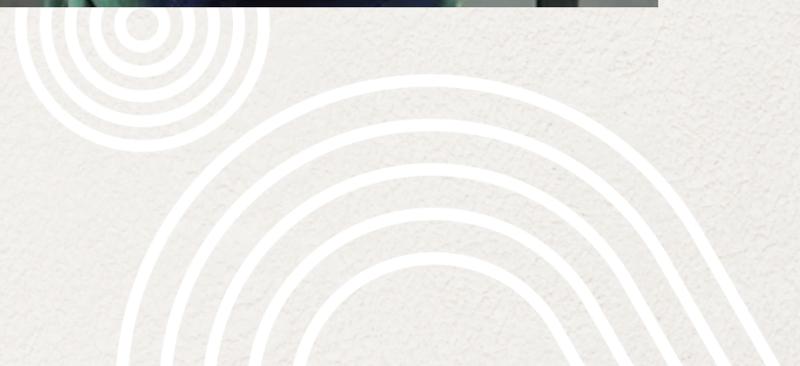




Creating a Safe and Respectful Learning Environment



- Zero tolerance for discrimination
- Respect for diverse backgrounds and experiences
- Inclusive language and examples
- Encouragement of respectful discussion



Supporting Academic Adjustment



- Recognise different educational backgrounds
- Provide guidance on academic writing and participation
- Offer additional explanations when needed
- Direct students to support services when appropriate



Emotional Awareness In Academic Support

- Notice signs of stress or withdrawal
- Respond with empathy and understanding
- Maintain professional boundaries
- Know when to refer students for additional support





Flexibility Within Academic Frameworks



- Reasonable flexibility with deadlines when justified
 - Alternative participation options when possible
 - Balance academic standards with compassion
 - Ensure fairness for all students
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Encouraging Student Voice and Participation

- Invite different perspectives
- Encourage Ukrainian students to share when comfortable
- Validate contributions
- Create opportunities for engagement



Inclusive Assessment Practices



- Transparent grading criteria
- Constructive and timely feedback
- Focus on learning progress
- Opportunities for improvement



Helping Students Navigate the University System



- Explain who does what in the institution
- Guide students to relevant offices and services
- Clarify academic and administrative procedures
- Reduce confusion and uncertainty



Benefits of Inclusive Academic Support

- Higher student satisfaction
- Improved academic performance
- Stronger sense of belonging
- More positive university experience for all students
