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# Why Communication Matters in Academic Support

- Effective communication builds trust
- Students feel seen and heard
- Misunderstandings are reduced
- Academic support becomes more meaningful



# What Is Active Listening?

- Listening with full attention
- Seeking to understand, not to judge
- Responding thoughtfully
- Showing empathy and respect



# Active Listening vs. Passive Listening

- Passive listening: hearing without engagement
- Active listening: understanding and responding
- Focus on the student's perspective
- Encourages open communication



# The Role of the Academic



- Creates a safe space for dialogue
- Encourages students to express concerns
- Interprets verbal and non-verbal cues
- Builds trust through consistent listening



# Key Elements of Active Listening

- Maintaining eye contact (when appropriate)
- Avoiding interruptions
- Asking open-ended questions
- Reflecting and summarising what is heard



# Creating a Safe Feedback Environment

- Respectful and non-judgmental tone
- Confidentiality and professionalism
- Acceptance of different experiences
- Encouragement of honest feedback



# Understanding Student Feedback

- Academic concerns
- Emotional or motivational challenges
- Uncertainty about expectations
- Difficulties with adaptation



# From Listening to Feedback Loops

- Listen to student input
- Acknowledge what is shared
- Respond with clarity
- Follow up when needed



# What Makes a Feedback Loop Effective?

- Timely responses
- Clear explanations
- Consistency in action
- Visibility of change or decision



# Managing Difficult Conversations



- Stay calm and focused
- Validate feelings without promising solutions
- Set clear boundaries
- Know when to refer students for additional support



# Active Listening in Diverse Classrooms

- Different communication styles
- Cultural sensitivity
- Language awareness
- Avoiding assumptions





# Benefits for Students

- Feeling respected and valued
- Increased trust in academics
- Greater engagement
- Reduced stress and confusion



# Benefits for Academics

- Better understanding of student needs
- Fewer misunderstandings
- Stronger academic relationships
- More effective support strategies



# Practical Tips for Academics

- Schedule regular check-ins
- Use reflective questions
- Summarise key points after discussions
- Encourage continuous dialogue
