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What Is Prior Learning?



- Formal education and qualifications
- Informal and non-formal learning
- Professional and life experiences
- Skills gained in different contexts



Why Prior Learning Matters

- Students arrive with diverse backgrounds
- Prior experiences shape learning styles
- Recognition builds confidence
- Valuing experience supports inclusion



The Role of the Academic

- Acknowledges diverse learning pathways
- Creates space for students' experiences
- Connects prior knowledge to new content
- Supports academic integration



Recognising Different Educational Systems



- Variation in curricula and assessment
- Different teaching and learning approaches
- Avoiding deficit-based assumptions
- Focusing on strengths and potential



Creating Opportunities to Share Experience



- Classroom discussions
- Reflective assignments
- Group work and peer exchange
- Voluntary sharing, not obligation



Validating Without Lowering Standards

- Respect experience while maintaining academic expectations
- Clarify equivalence and learning outcomes
- Ensure transparency and fairness
- Balance recognition and requirements



Using Prior Learning as a Learning Resource

- Link theory to real-life experience
- Encourage peer learning
- Enrich discussions with diverse perspectives
- Strengthen relevance of course content





Supporting Academic Confidence



- Acknowledge existing skills
- Encourage transfer of knowledge
- Reduce self-doubt and insecurity
- Promote active participation



Addressing Gaps Respectfully

- Identify learning needs without stigma
- Provide clear guidance for development
- Offer additional resources
- Frame gaps as part of learning



Prior Learning in Assessment and Feedback

- Transparent assessment criteria
- Feedback linked to individual progress
- Recognition of applied knowledge
- Clear expectations for improvement



Cultural Sensitivity in Recognition

- Different attitudes toward self-presentation
- Avoid pressure to self-promote
- Respect cultural communication styles
- Encourage participation in multiple ways



Benefits for Students



- Increased sense of value and respect
- Stronger academic identity
- Greater engagement and motivation
- Smoother academic transition



Benefits for the Learning Environment

- Richer classroom discussions
- Mutual respect among students
- More inclusive learning culture
- Better use of collective knowledge



Practical Actions for Academics

- Ask about students' backgrounds early
- Design flexible learning activities
- Encourage experience-based examples
- Reflect diversity in teaching materials
